Road Construction

The information we have received from highways is that they will be working in the Village of Chitek Lake and hope that all the paving in the Village will be completed early in the summer. They will also be working on the highway and weather permitting be done by late fall.

If any resident is having their driveway paved at their own cost while the crew is in the Village we would like to remind you that there is a right of way waiver to be filled out at the office if paving will be done over the Village easement. The Village will not be responsible for any damages to paving on easement due to grading or any other work is required such as but not limited to culvert repair or replace.

Waste Water

Please ensure regular monitoring of your septic tanks. Contact village shop at (306) 984-2358 to arrange a pump out. Septic service is Monday to Friday and this schedule will continue throughout the summer, there will be no service on stat holidays.

Tanks are expected to be pumped at once per week, if you require a pump out more than once it may indicate an issue that needs to be resolved.

Please be reminded that once a household has received 5 “dips”, they will be charged \$30 per dip”. Dip means wastewater is lower than 1 foot marked on a measuring stick. If you are on a regular schedule and will be away or do not need weekly service please call to change your schedule.

Camping Chitek Lake and Little Shell

Booking for camp ground sites 2023 opened on April 3, 2023 you can go to Let's Camp for bookings.

At Chitek Lake from April 3 to 17 we are accepting week long bookings and on April 17 you will be able to book a minimum of 2 nights.

Little Shell is open for bookings of all time frames.

Bylaw for Establishing a Fee for Use of the Boat Launch Facility

This new Bylaw passed in March will allow non-taxed users to obtain a Daily, Weekly or Seasonal Pass to use the boat launch, fish fileting stations, and parking lot.

The fees are as follow:

Day Pass Fee	\$10
Week Pass Fee	\$20
Season Pass Fee	\$60
Resident Pass	Please contact Village Office
Fine for Parking without Visible Pass	\$50
Fine for Improper Parking in Boat Launch Area	\$300 and subject to towing

Taxes and Shoreline Lease

Taxes and boat dock lease invoices will be sent out early in June.

There is a 4% discount on 2023 property taxes until September 30, 2023. Taxes are due by December 31, 2023

Boat dock lease fees are due by Dec.31, 2023

All cabin/homeowners are asked to clearly mark their lease with their number and mark all property on the shoreline with the same number.
