

RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE

BYLAW NUMBER 15

A BYLAW PERMITTING THE USE OF PLASTIC PIPE WHERE NO PLUMBING BYLAW EXISTS.

A BYLAW TO EXTEND THE PERMITTED USE OF PLASTIC PLUMBING MATERIAL.

UNDER THE PRIVISIONS OF Section 83 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, R.S.S. 1978, THE COUNCIL OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE, CHITEK LAKE, IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN.

enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Saskatchewan Plumbing and Drainage Regulations, 1978, enacted under the Public Health Act the Paul and Rita Loisselle of Lot 14 Block F, Plan BW 930, in Chitek Lake, Saskatchewan, is hereby authorized to use plastic pipe and fittings in the plubing system serving the structure known as Rita's Inn, located on Lot 14 Block F, Plan BW 930, in Chitek Lake, Saskatchewan.

2. The alteration of such plumbing shall comply to the requirements stipulated under subsection (a) and (b):

a) Combustible drain, waste and vent piping shall not be used in a plumbing system within a building where part of the system is located within or passes through a fire separation required to have a fire-resistance rating, except that where drain, waste and vent piping penetrates through a vertical fire separation, the piping on one side may be comustible provided the combustibile piping is not located in a vertica; sjaft pr om a fire seperation required to have a fire-resistance rating.

b) Meet the requirements imposed by;

i) The office of the Provincial Fire Commissioner.

3 This bylaw shall come into forc and effect upon approval of the Minister of Health.
