BYLAW NO 134/2018

A BYLAW TO ALLOW A RESTAURANT PERMIT AS DEFINED IN *THE ALCOHOL AND GAMING REGULATIONS, 2016 (Act)* WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE

WHEREAS the Council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake has conducted a plebiscite to allow for "Restaurant Permit" as defined in the Act or to prohibit liquor sales within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake.

The results of said plebiscite on May 31, 2018 was to allow a "Restaurant Permit".

THE COUNCIL OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. SHORT TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as the bylaw to allow a restaurant permit for sale of liquor.

2. PURPOSE

Council deems best practice speaks to the need to:

- i. Decrease potential for alcohol related harms within the community including, but not limited to, disturbing the peace, impaired driving, offences against persons;
- ii. Avoid an extra burden on emergency service resources including, but not limited to, law enforcement, transportation services, healthcare resources.

In accordance with The Municipalities Act which gives municipalities general authority to pass bylaws within their areas of jurisdiction in addition to specific areas, and Section 8.3 (d) which states that any municipality may pass a bylaw "to prohibit a business or class of business from operating" or "to limit the number of businesses in a particular class of business that may operate", this Bylaw is enacted to allow the restaurant establishment be a permitted premises within the municipality.

3. DEFINITIONS

- i. "Permitted Premises" means the premises for which a permit is issued, except premises referred to in a permit to
 - (a) sell or consume beverage alcohol at a special occasion

- ii. "Permit" means a permit issued pursuant to The Alcohol and Gaming Regulation Act, 1997 (Act) or the regulations for the possession, sale, keeping for sale, use, importation or manufacture of beverage alcohol.

4. Restaurant permit requirements Section 13 of the Act:

The holder of a restaurant permit shall ensure that the food to beverage alcohol sales value ratio on the permitted premises is at least one dollar of food sales for every one dollar of beverage alcohol sales.

Hours of operation to sell alcohol beverages with food sales shall not be any earlier than 10:00 AM and no later than 10:00 PM.

5. Chapter III Section 3 (b) Commercial Liquor Policy Manual, October 9, 2016: **WILL NOT** permit the following: a banquet room endorsement; a catering endorsement, a lounge endorsement, a tavern endorsement, a wine and approved beer off-sale endorsement, a patio endorsement, a room service endorsement, a mini-bar endorsement, or a sidewalk café endorsement.

Please Note: "Special Occasion Permits" will not change. Special occasion permits will be permitted at the community hall, the ball diamond and to all businesses etc. in conjunction to special occasions.

6. COMING INTO FORCE

This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final reading.
