

RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE
BYLAW NO. 70/2006

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 60/2005 known as the Basic Planning Statement

The Council of The Resort Village of Chitek Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 60/2005 as follows:

1. The first paragraph of Section 3.1 is amended from “bank stability and erosion” to “bank instability and erosion”.
2. The last two bullets of Section 3.3.8 are deleted and replaced with “Any concerns of Council regarding non-residential traffic or parking are resolved through the application of appropriate conditions on the required permit.
3. Section 6.3.5 is amended from “methods uses” to “methods used”.
4. The Basic Planning Statement Map referred to in Section 8 is amended by designating Parcel D, Plan 77B04148 to Future Urban Development.
5. The Basic Planning Statement Map referred to in Section 8 is amended by redesignating from Future Urban Development to Residential, 18.29 metres on the West side of proposed Parcel G so that all that land shown within the bold dashed line on the attached plan of proposed subdivision dated November 8, 2005 and signed by Michael L. Waschuk, SLS, which forms part of this bylaw is designated Residential.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister of Government Relations.
