

**RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE  
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN**

**BYLAW 158/2022**

**A BYLAW TO RENAME AND AMEND BYLAW 62/05 KNOWN AS THE BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF  
CAMPER TRAILER PARKS**

The Council of the of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to rename and amend bylaw 62/05 as follows:

1. **Rename the Bylaw as THE BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PLACEMENT AND USE OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES IN THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN**
2. Amend point number 3 to read the following:

The placement of a recreational vehicle on a residential property where a **principle dwelling exists** is subject to the following requirements:

- a. A maximum of **two** recreational vehicles may be placed on the property.
- b. The recreation vehicles may be occupied for a maximum of **30 consecutive days** subject to being used for the exclusive temporary use of the owner or non-paying guests of the owner of the property.
- c. A permit for occupancy in excess of 30 days may be obtained by the approval of Council and will be subject to \$100 fee per recreational vehicle.

The placement of a recreational vehicle on a residential property where **no principle dwelling exists but a building caveat is registered** on the property, is subject to the following requirements:

- d. A maximum of **two** recreational vehicles may be placed on the property.
- e. Occupancy of the recreational vehicles require a permit, which may be obtained by approval of Council. The permit will be subject to a \$100 fee per recreational vehicle paid each calendar year.

The placement of a recreational vehicle on a residential property where **no principle dwelling exists and no caveat is registered** on the property, is subject to the following requirements:

- f. A maximum of **two** recreational vehicles may be placed on the property.
- g. Occupancy of the recreational vehicles require a permit, which may be obtained by approval of Council. The permit will be subject to a \$500 fee per recreational vehicle paid each calendar year.

3. Replace wording of point number 4 with the following: **All fees are subject to change and permit may be revoked by Council at any time.**
4. Replace wording of point number 5 with the following: **The recreation vehicle cannot be untidy or in an unsightly condition. Council has the authority to request the recreational vehicle be removed from the property and/or will have it removed at the owner's expense.**
5. Add point number 6. **Any outstanding fees as of December 31 of the current year may be transferred to taxes and be collectable by tax enforcement.**

6. This bylaw shall come into force on the third reading by Council effective August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
