
A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE
BEING A BYLAW CONCERNING CONTROL AND REGULATION OF PUBLIC PLACES

The Council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts pursuant to Section 157 (c) of the Urban Municipality Act, 1984 the following:

1. For the purpose of this Bylaw the terms:
 - (a) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Chitek Lake;
 - (b) "Land" means the following land:
 - i.) Public reserve on the lake side of Chitek Drive and Lakeshore Drive;
 - ii.) Public reserve between Block G and Lot 1, Block 1;
 - iii.) Public reserve between Lot 12 and Lot 13, Block H;
 - iv.) Public reserve in Block N;
 - v.) Public reserve in Block M;
 - vi.) Ball diamond area in Parcel G;
 - vii.) Public reserve on Tyndall Place
 - viii.) Any other public place
2. No person shall park vehicles, overnight camp or have open fires on public reserve or any public place within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake.
3. Council shall cause to be erected and maintained signs at any designated point or points thereon, of such signs as it may deem expedient for warning, guidance, directions or information thereon.
4. Any member of the police force, special constable or other person appointed by council may remove or cause to be removed any vehicle that is unlawfully placed, left or kept on any public area and to impound or store such vehicle or may enforce this bylaw.
5. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and shall upon summary conviction be liable to the penalties provided by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake.
6. This bylaw shall come into force on the third reading of council
