

BYLAW NO. 7/79

A BYLAW RESTRICTING AND PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY

The Council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Definitions:

- (a) "Livestock" as used in this bylaw means cattle, goats, horses, sheep, swine and all fur bearing animals.
- (b) "Poultry" means chickens, ducks, geese and turkeys.
- (c) "Village" means Resort Village of Chitek Lake.

- 2. No person shall herd cattle at any time within the limits of the Village unless they obtain special permission from Village Council (in writing), and are liable for any damages incurred by the herding of their cattle through the village.
- 3. No person shall keep, at any time, livestock and/or poultry within the corporate limits of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan.
- 4. (a) A person who infringes any of the provisions of this bylaw or fails to comply therewith is guilty of an offence shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than \$10 nor more than \$200.
(b) The imposition of such penalty for failure to comply with any of the provisions of this bylaw shall not relieve the person in default from carrying out the work therein mentioned, but he shall be liable on summary conviction to a further penalty of not less than \$2 nor more than \$20 for each day after the first penalty is imposed until he has complied with the provisions of this bylaw.
- 5. This bylaw will come into force on the date of its passing.
- 6. Read three times by unanimous vote, and passed by the Council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake, in the Province of Saskatchewan this 19th day of June A.D. 1979.
