Recycle Allowable

Commingled system will collect all fibers. Brown is for WASTE Blue is for Recycle

***Paper and Cardboard**

Some samples of what is ok. Flattened Cardboard and Paper board, cereal boxes, detergent boxes, tissue boxes, newspapers, flyers, inserts, junk mail, magazines, catalogues, paperback books, telephone books, letter quality paper, brown paper bags, tissue roll cores, envelopes with or without windows, copier paper, computer printouts, and NCR (no carbon required).

Non allowable Paper – Waxed, plasticized, food contaminated paper or cardboard, cups or plates. Soiled tissues, napkins and paper towels, styro foam or foam packaging

***Plastics**

All grades of household plastics number 1 thru 7 as well as non-contaminated food wrap and plastic shopping bags.

This could be everything from the kitchen, pantry, bathroom, and laundry room. Make sure all are rinsed out.

Non allowable Plastics – Oil jugs, Styrofoam, auto parts, contaminated food or product wrap, outside plastics, lawn chairs, kid's toys, outdoor plastic furniture and no glass.

***Tin**

All canned foods, and any household use tin and aluminum is allowed. Make sure all are rinsed out.

Non allowable Tin- Scrap metals, propane tanks, gas or fuel containers, wire or plastic hangers, and scrap wire, and glass.

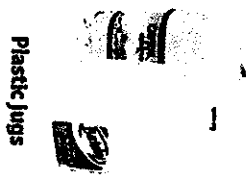

Estimated Decomposition Rates of Certain Items

Garbage Item	Estimated Decomposition Time in a Landfill
Aluminum can	200 - 400 years
Banana	3 - 5 weeks
Cigarette butt	2 - 5 years
Glass bottle	500 years
Milk carton	5 years
Paper bag	2 - 4 weeks
Plastic drink rings	450 years
Plastic jug	450 years
Styrofoam cup	never
Tin can	100 years
Plastic bag	10 - 20 years
Rubber sole of shoe	50 - 80 years
