


THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE  
IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN  
BYLAW 120/2016

A BYLAW OF THE RESORT VILLAGE OF CHITEK LAKE TO ESTABLISH  
A LIMIT ON CASH COLLECTIONS

The Council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
  - a. "Designated Officer" shall mean
    - i) The person appointed by the Administrator of the municipality; or
    - ii) The person who has been delegated authority to collect and deposit cash receipts belonging to the municipality;
  - b. "Council" means the Council for the Resort Village of Chitek Lake;
  - c. "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Chitek Lake.
2. The designated officer shall deposit in the name of the Municipality, in a financial institution designated by Council, all cash moneys collected and receipted when they have accumulated to the amount of \$1000.00.
3. At the direction of the designated officer, deposits may be made more frequently but in any case, not less than once a month nor more than once per each day.
4. Read a third time and adopted on this 26<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2016.
