BYLAW 50/04

A BYLAW TO REGULATE SMOKING IN THE  
COMMUNITY HALL AND SENIOR CENTRE

The council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1. In this Bylaw:
  - a) "Municipality" shall mean the Resort Village of Chitek Lake;
  - b) "Community Hall and Senior Centre" shall mean the Chitek Lake Community Hall and Senior Centre;
  - c) "Smoke" or "Smoking" shall mean any lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe or other smoking device;
  - d) "Council" shall mean the council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake.
2. No person shall smoke in the Chitek Lake Community Hall or Senior Centre.
3. The Council shall be authorized to place at the Community Hall and Senior Centre and at any other location in the Community Hall and Senior Centre, signs to inform members of the public of any provision of this Bylaw.
4. The signs authorized in Section 3 of this Bylaw are provided only as a courtesy, and do not preclude any person or persons from compliance with the provisions of this Bylaw.
5. Any person or persons who contravene the provisions of this Bylaw is guilty of an offense and punishable on summary conviction and shall be liable to the penalty of \$100.00.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2004.
