BYLAW 115/2016

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT RESPECTING THE
PROVISION OF FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES

The Council of the Resort Village of Chitek Lake in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Resort Village of Chitek Lake is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw, and identified as listed below with the following municipalities:

for the purpose of providing and/or receiving fire protection services.

EXHIBIT "B" TO BYLAW 115/2016

Memorandum of Agreement between:

The Resort Village of Chitek Lake

AND

The RM of Spiritwood #496

This agreement Witnesseth as Follows:

WHEARAS the Resort Village of Chitek Lake has established and maintains a fire department for the provision of fire protection services to all residents within its corporate boundaries;

WHEREAS the RM of Spiritwood #496 has established and maintains a fire department for the provision of fire protection services to all residents within its corporate boundaries;

The parties to this agreement agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. The municipalities named in this agreement agree to provide fire protection services in the form of women/men and equipment to property located within the corporate boundaries and under the municipal jurisdiction of each party to this agreement when the fire chief or his designate deems it necessary and desirable.
2. Each municipality signing this agreement agrees to accept the invoice for any fire call services provided by itself, and in turn invoice the actual recipient of the services for the charges. If the charges referred to remain unpaid by the recipient of the service sixty days after the service is received, the municipality in which the recipient's property is located will pay the charges to the municipality which provided the said service.

3. It is further understood that in the event of a fire, that the first fire chief on the scene shall be deemed to be in charge of the situation, unless the fire chief from the municipality in which the fire has occurred, arrives after the municipality concerned should have control of the situation.
4. It is further understood by both parties to this agreement that the said agreement does not refer to calls made to First Nations Reserves.
5. It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall commence on Mar 31, 2016 and be continuous. This agreement may be terminated by either party to the agreement by giving 30 days notice in writing.
